fi360 Reaches Settlement in Copyright Infringement Litigation

PITTSBURGH, PA, June 28, 2011 -- Fiduciary360 (fi360) today announced that a settlement has been reached in *Center for Fiduciary Studies, LLC, Fiduciary Analytics, LLC and Fiduciary360, LP v. Foundation for Fiduciary Studies and Donald B. Trone, Jr.*, which was filed in Pennsylvania's Western District Court on July 9, 2010 concerning an intellectual property rights dispute. As a result of the terms of the agreement, fi360 has settled differences with Donald B. Trone, Jr., a former co-owner of fi360, and the Foundation for Fiduciary Studies.
