He is a tenured Professor of Finance at Virginia Commonwealth University, is a FINRA arbitrator, and serves on the Investment Committee for the Optional Retirement Plan at VCU. Professor Upton previously taught at Texas Tech University and the University of Kentucky, and has been a Visiting Professor at Misr International University, Cairo; the University of Guadalajara, Mexico; the Pacific Asian Management Institute at the University of Hawaii at Manoa; and at the University of Petroleum at Changping, Guangzhou, and Zhangjiang, PRC. He has published in journals such as the Journal of Finance, the Journal of Financial and Quantitative Analysis, and Decision Science, and has presented numerous professional seminars domestically and worldwide.
