Jolie H. Matthews is Senior Health & Life Policy Counsel at the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC), where she specializes in issues related to health insurance and life insurance. Her responsibilities include staffing the NAIC's health insurance committee – Health Insurance & Managed Care Committee. In addition, Ms. Matthews staffs the Regulatory Framework Task Force, which is one of the main task forces under the Health Insurance & Managed Care Committee. This task force is charged with developing NAIC model acts and regulations for state health insurance initiatives, and with considering policy issues affecting state health insurance regulation. Ms. Matthews also provides NAIC staff support to the NAIC's Life Insurance & Annuities Committee and some of its working groups.
