

Tom Higgins is the Chief Economist at Payden & Rygel Investment Counsel. He is responsible for developing views on the U.S. and global economy. Before joining Payden, Tom was employed at The Conference Board where he served as the International Economist. At the Board, he produced reports on the global economic outlook as well as maintaining the exchange rate models for the U.S. economic forecast. Tom has been quoted in the Los Angeles Times and Wall Street Journal. He has also appeared on CNBC, Bloomberg Television, and Fox Business News. Tom received a University Fellowship from Fordham University in 1995 and completed his Ph.D. in Economics in 2001. His dissertation titled, "The Term Structure and Recessions," analyzed the linkages between the shape of the yield curve and recessions across the G-7 economies.
